Wire mesh cable trays offer flexibility in design, allowing for bends that help installers navigate complex layouts, avoid obstacles, and ensure proper cable routing. While rare, I have encountered situations where I have seen vertical ladder cable tray "jog" left or right to avoid obstacles, while heavy gauge cables in the tray are zip-tied/clamped to the rungs. Each cable tray type performs a different function and comes in various materials such as aluminum, galvanized steel, and FRP.
