A fiber-optic cable, also known as an optical-fiber cable, is an assembly similar to an electrical cable but containing one or more optical fibers that are used to carry light. The optical fiber elements are typically individually coated with plastic layers and contained in a protective tube. These connections utilize coaxial cables, which are made of copper, instead of fiber optic cables, which use small, flexible strands of glass or plastic. Because it's a less efficient way to transmit data, cable internet has a lower bandwidth limit than fiber optic connections.
