

Cameroon Optical Cable Laying Construction



Overview

Cameroon's incumbent telecom operator, Camtel, has announced the deployment of an additional 3,500 km of fiber optic cable starting in 2024. Speaking about the project last October 17 during the Yaoundé Digital Week, MD Judith Yah Sunday said it primarily targets rural areas. On June 19, the two organizations signed a framework agreement for mutual infrastructure sharing. "This collaboration.
