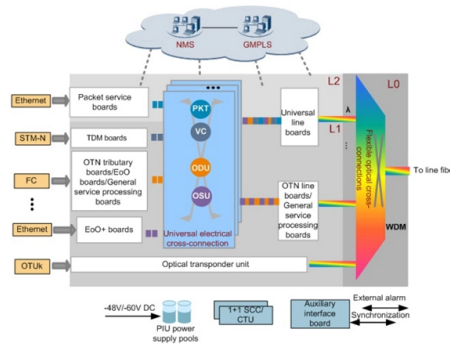


Cross-street fiber optic cable height



Overview

The basic pole height is 7m and the tip diameter is 150mm. In case of special sections, crossing obstacles or roads or railways, the pole height of 8m, 9m, etc. can be selected according to the actual terrain. The Fiber Optic Association, Inc.
