

How high should the embedded parts of the cable tray be



Overview

Telecommunications standard TIA/EIA-569 recommends a minimum of 12-inch access headroom above the cable tray. Cable trays play a vital role in supporting electrical cables and wires in commercial, industrial, and utility installations. For proper installation, design, and maintenance, adherence to international standards is essential. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. cable trays are equivalent.
