

How to access the small busbar at the top of the cabinet



Overview

Unscrew the two fixing screws at the top of the feed unit. 5 kV busbar compartment from rear side (AFLR): Remove the rear cover (4) of the cubicle by unscrewing M8 screws (2) and washers (3) provided on rear cover (4).
