

Junction box is fixed and does not rotate



Overview

What is stopping you from turning the box back to the original position?

The mounting bracket with the fixture should adjust to allow the orientation you need. A junction box is an important feature of an electrical system as it serves the different connections towards achieving the goal of a proper electrical distribution without leading to short circuits. Be it a wall-mounted junction box, a ceiling light junction box, or an outdoor one, all require. I bought a light fixture for my bathroom and noticed the screw holes on the fixture are in a N/S orientation, while the junction box is in an E/W orientation. I am able to rotate the existing bracket to accommodate the different orientation (the one that came with the fixture is too small), but I'm. The left side of the box is probably mounted to the stud so grab a longer drywall or deck screw, I think 3" long and go in through one of the holes in the back of the box at an angle left and drive the screw into the stud. Stop tightening once the box is pulled in on the right.
