

Level 2 distribution box repeated grounding



Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be $< 1 \Omega$. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. Grounding of the units: Attach a ground wire from one of. Grounding is a mechanism to protect distribution equipment and people under normal operating conditions, abnormal operational (overcurrent and overvoltage) responses, and hazardous conditions such as shocks. Grounding is necessary to assure correct operation of electrical devices, to assure safety. The International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) has gradually moved away from multiple earthing (also known as repeated grounding) in electrical systems. This shift is driven by safety concerns, electromagnetic compatibility, system stability, and the evolving needs of modern power.
