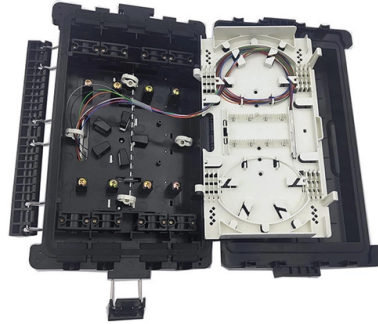


Minimum length of optical cable

Optical cable length limits depend on the interface and fiber type: keep consumer TOSLINK/SPDIF under about 15 m for reliable audio. Some cables reach ~30 m but risk dropouts. Treat ADAT/Lightpipe conservatively unless your gear specifies longer spans. Use multimode fiber for short-to-medium runs.
