Overview

This test may be performed with any TestPro using the AD-NET-CABLE adapter or with any Network Service Assistant using the AD-NSA adapter. In most environments, technicians “test” PoE by connecting the powered device (PD). However, just because a device doesn't light up doesn't mean that PoE is. This document describes how to troubleshoot Power over Ethernet (PoE) on Catalyst 9000 PoE-capable switching platforms. Cisco recommends that you have knowledge of these topics:
