Like SFP+, it is backward compatible with SFP modules — an SFP28 port accepts SFP and SFP+ modules at reduced speeds. QSFP (Quad SFP) integrates four lanes in one module. QSFP28 does 4x25 Gbps or 4x28 Gbps (100 Gbps). SFP28 (Small Form-Factor Pluggable 28) is an enhanced version of SFP+, designed to support 25Gb/s data rate transmission while maintaining the same package type. What is an optical transceiver?
