The five causes are: a settled or tilted box, outlet clogs from solids carryover, root intrusion or crushed laterals, cracked or deteriorated box structure, and a saturated drainfield that mimics D-box symptoms. A septic distribution box (D-box) is a concrete or plastic junction that evenly distributes wastewater from your septic tank to all drainfield lateral lines. When it fails, symptoms include uneven wet spots in the yard, slow indoor drains, and sewage odors. When this critical component becomes blocked, wastewater may back up into the home, flood the drainfield, or contaminate surrounding soil and. Septic tank distribution boxes play a crucial role in the functionality of a septic system. But you should also check the septic tank condition. At its core is the distribution box, or D-box.
