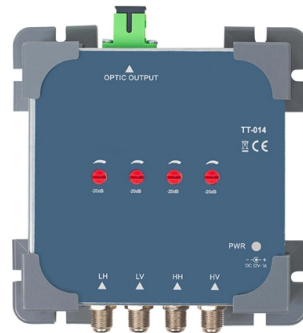


What specifications of round steel should be used for cable tray supports



Overview

The standard ensures these systems can handle the physical and electrical loads they're exposed to over time. A cable support system consists of cable support lengths and system components, such as cable support fittings, support elements, mounting.

- Installation of perforated GI Cable tray of size 300 x 50 mm at height ~12 meter on wall and existing metal support structure.

Armorduct cable tray systems are usually assembled using M6 roofing bolts particularly for couplers, fishplates and connection to supporting framework.
